By car

The assessment centre is located in the city centre on Maid Marian Way (A6008), which can be accessed via Derby Road or Castle Boulevard. Please note that the centre is located within a one-way system.

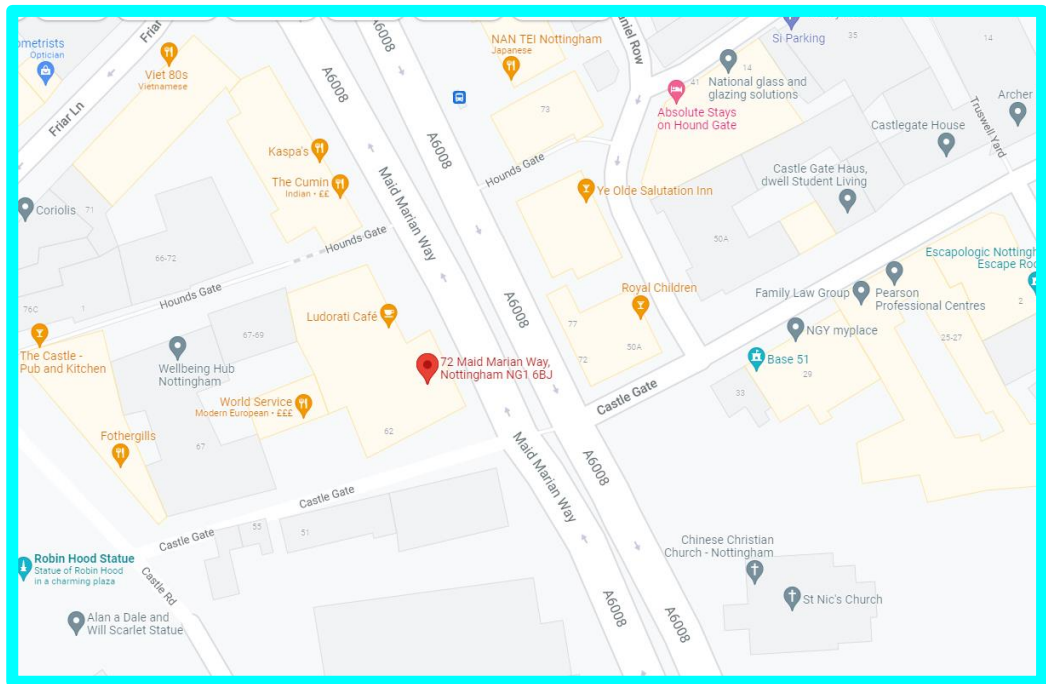
The centre is directly opposite Ye Old A Salutation Inn (pub) and two doors from Kaspas Dessert Restaurant.



Parking

The closest car park is St James Street Car Park, which is a few minutes' walk away. The post code to use is NG1 6EY. There is no designated drop off area immediately outside of the assessment centre, however visitors can be dropped off at Friar Lane approximately 500ft from the building.

By train

The nearest train station is Nottingham Train Station, located less than 1 mile (approx. 10 mins) from the assessment centre. Exit the station and walk towards Tesco Express.

Turn right onto Carrington Street. Follow the road until you reach Cafe Nero, then turn left onto Canal Street. Follow Canal Street round to the right onto Greyfriar Gate. Turn left onto Maid Marian Way and follow the road to the right. Continue past St Nic's Church on the right. Castle Heights is further along the road on the left.

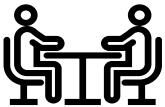
Taxis are available outside of the train station and take around 5 minutes to reach Castle Heights.

By bus

The assessment centre is serviced by bus routes 77, 78 and 79 (Turquoise line) 50, N34 and 34 (Orange line) the Nottingham Light Centre 1, 3, 4, N4, 48 and 49 Navy line.



When you arrive

Remember to bring two forms of ID with you.

When you arrive at the centre, please go directly to the third floor to sign in.

There are two lifts available to the third floor and you will need to turn left when you get out of the lift.



Useful info

There are ramps and lifts available.

The assessment centre also has accessible toilets and a side door for disabled access.
