By car

At the Lodge Road roundabout in Coleraine, take the lane for the town centre and continue on Lodge Road for approximately 100 metres.

Turn left onto Nursery Avenue. Continue on Nursery Avenue straight to the right-hand lane on Terrace Row. At the traffic lights at the end of Terrace Row, turn right and continue in the right-hand lane onto Dunmore Street (signs for Abbey Street car park).

The consultation centre is a black marble building at the edge of Abbey Street car park directly across the road from the back door of Marks and Spencer's.



By bus

The consultation centre is in Coleraine town centre and is a 10-15 minute walk from the bus and train station.

The closest bus stop is The Mall (BT52 1PQ), which is 0.2 miles (4 minute walk) from the consultation centre.

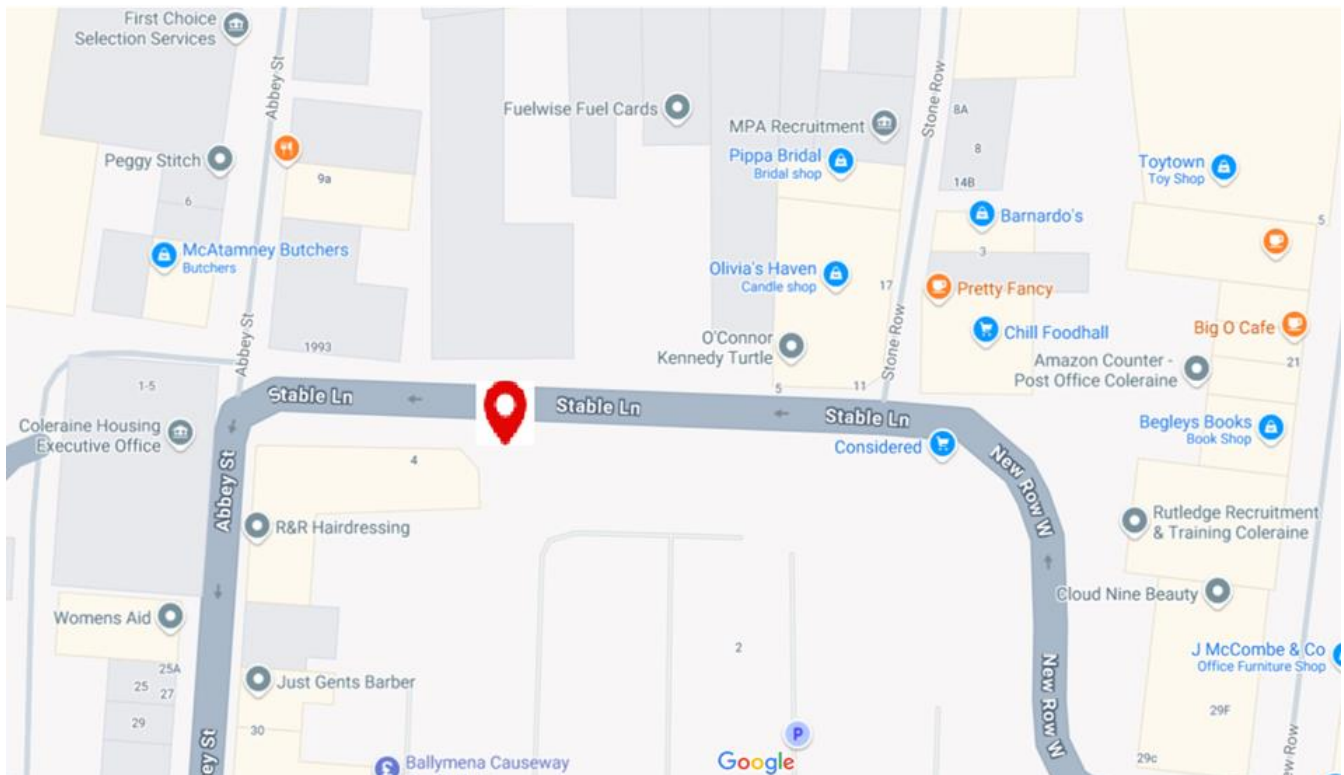
Make your way to the pedestrianised shopping area and continue towards the Town Hall. Turn left at Bishops Shoe Shop onto Abbey Street. Turn left at Abbey Insurance onto Stable Lane and the consultation centre is on the right-hand side of the road next to Louise McKeag Opticians.



By train

Coleraine train station is next to the bus station and is a 10-15 minute walk to the consultation centre.

Parking

Abbey Street car park pay and display (BT52 1DQ) is less than 500 feet from the centre.

There are 4 disabled parking spaces directly outside the consultation centre and 6 in Abbey Street car park..



When you arrive

Remember to bring two forms of ID with you.

You will enter the consultation centre through automatic doors.

When you arrive please press the buzzer at the right-hand side of the entrance which will enable you to speak to reception.

Please let the Receptionist know that you have arrived for an appointment.
