There is a pay and display car park on Orchard Street at City Hall (LN1 1DD).



Directions by train

Lincoln train station is 0.4 miles away from the Centre.

Exit the station and turn left down St Mary's Street. Cross over the pedestrian crossing and take a right onto the High Street, then left onto Guildhall Street. Continue and turn right onto Beaumont Fee, taking the next left onto Park Street. The Centre, inside City Hall, is further up on your left.

Directions by bus

Lincoln bus station is 0.6 miles from the Centre.

Leave the station, turn right onto Sincil Street and then turn left along the canal. Turn right onto the High Street and continue towards the Stonebow (stone archway), then left onto Guildhall Street. Cross over at the end of the street and take the next right onto Beaumont Fee, then left onto Park Street. The Centre, inside City Hall, is farther up on the left.

Directions by car

From A46: take the A57 Saxilby Road into Lincoln. Turn left on Carholme Road and then right onto Newland. Turn left into Orchard Street for the car park — which is opposite the Centre.
